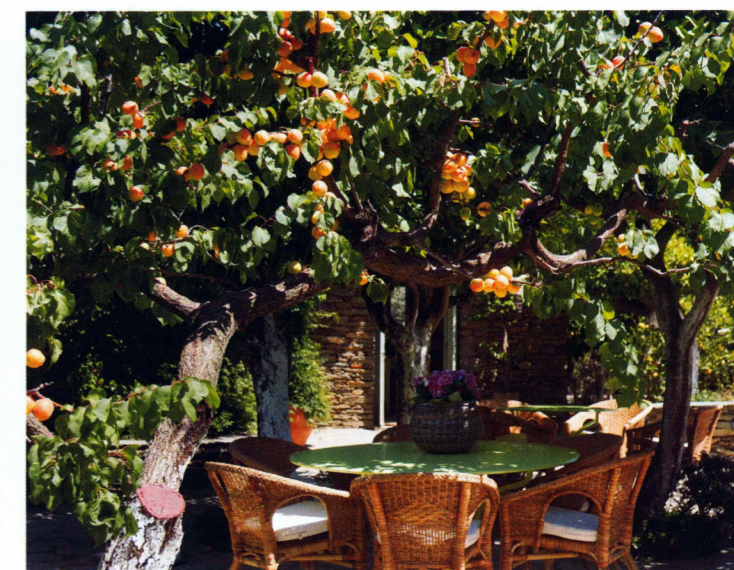


Ktima Lemonies

Situated on the island of Andros, Ktima Lemonies is a cute bed and breakfast created from an old restored farmhouse. A hidden gem, the guesthouse and stables are set in a 3-acre (1.2-hectare) property with olive and fruit trees, cypresses, vegetable gardens, and a small swimming pool.

Owners Michalis and Nelly restored the property with care, converted the old farmhouse into a few rooms and a suite, creating a place where guests could spend weekends and holidays. The suite offers a double bedroom and two single beds, which is perfect for families, and the other three rooms, which are all doubles, are sweet, cozy, and full of character. In fact, one of the rooms was converted from the old pigsty and has a ceiling made out of massive stone slates.

Everything at the guesthouse was done in a charming country-style: floors were made from pale brick; most of the furniture is antique; the beds are very comfy and bathrooms with walk-in showers are pretty. The gardens are paradise on earth. Guests can stroll around the terraced gardens and admire everything that grows and blossoms; sitting corners are shaded by lemon and apricot trees; and a selection of sunbeds by the swimming pool allow guests to work on their tans.
